

Dear Friends and Colleagues,

We wish to inform you that Nyepi (Seclusion) Day this year will fall on **19 March 2007** which is a national public holiday in Indonesia.

Nyepi Day is the New Year for Balinese Hindu religion, and it is not celebrated as a party. The Hindu worshippers enter the new year with pray. They will put the light off, and release themselves from any work and activities. Therefore, Nyepi Day is generally known as 'Black Out Day'.

For 24 hours (early morning of 19 March to the next morning) the whole island of Bali will apply the followings

- No lights** are allowed. Hotels will be able to turn their lights at limited level.
- No outside activities** are allowed. Hotel guest should remain in the hotel premises.
Walking at hotel's beach is prohibited.
- No arrival/departure flights** will operate to/from Bali.

We kindly ask you to advise all your clients accordingly to avoid future disappointment. If you have clients already booked to Bali and they will be on the island on 19 March 2007, please make sure they are well informed of this Nyepi (Seclusion) Day.
